Agenda 2

To identify the specific areas of research to explore on following themes

- I. Synthesis of Child Related Knowledge- Systems (Physical, Psychological, Cultural and Medical)
- II. National and International Education, Children's Rights, Human Rights, Fundamental Duties, Ideal of Human Unity and Futuristic Visions
- III. Development of Integral Personality, Gifted Children, Physically and mentally Challenged Children
- IV. Children's Philosophy; Psychology, Sociology, Science & Technology and Toy Innovation

Resolution:

1. It was derived from the meeting that "Toys Innovation and Children's Sociology are to be added in the 4th theme of the Research council i.e. "Children's Philosophy; Children's Psychology, Children's Science, Children's Technology"

Amplified

2. Researches should be conducted pertaining to impact of toys on socialization, language and personality development of the children. Toys, Games, Cartoons, Film and Videos etc. should be studied in association with one another. Work should be done on the development of age specific toys.
3. Toy Innovation Department experts' should visit various places of India such as Vadhvana, Mahua and Ider etc. where toy manufacturing is being done. It will be instrumental in developing the deep insight of University experts into the Toy industry. Toy innovation department should conduct survey of online and offline toy market.
4. Children's language development, Creativity, Children's literature, Child development process and their interest in animation should also be studied.
5. Indian Music, Dance Art and Language should be promoted for development of children.
6. University should come up with age specific yoga for children. The subject of Yoga should be discussed at length in the subsequent meeting.
7. Studies should be conducted over diversities among children across culture, community, state, geographical area etc.
8. Research Ethics committee should be formed.
9. The approach should be characterised by holistic and integrated approach to the developmental domains of physical, intellectual, language, emotional, social, moral and sexual domains. Symbiotic mother infant bonding, parenting, sibling relations and prosocial behaviours deserve attention. The approach should be child centric and involve process and outcome evaluation with emphasis on cost benefit analysis.


Agenda 3. To identify the resource persons to contribute in exploring the given themes.
