1.4:

The University shall constitute a Committee for Recognition as Ph. D. Guide with the following as members to evaluate the application with regard to the fulfilment of the above criteria before recommending recognition of a teacher as a Ph. D. guide: (1) Head of the PG Department concerned (Chairman of the Committee); (2) Director school concerned; (3) Chairman of the Board of the Studies; (4) One expert in the relevant subject from outside the Department; and (5) Two senior teachers of the related subject in the PG Department, who is an active researcher.

All the members of this committee shall hold a Ph. D. degree and be recognised Ph. D. Guides.

This committee shall hold office for three years. It shall meet at least once a year to consider applications for recommending recognition as Ph.D. guide by deciding on each case individually on merit, taking into account the applicable above criteria. In absence of above constituted committee the VC will constitute committee.

1.5:

A Ph. D. guide shall produce at least one Ph. D. student during the last five years after the student is allotted to him/her and shall register at least one Ph.D student for continuation his/her recognition as a guide, failing which his/her recognition as guide shall stand cancelled and he/she shall be required to seek re-recognition as a Ph. D. guide.

1.6:

A person recognized as a Ph. D. guide by this University or other universities shall be automatically recognized as a Ph. D. guide in this University upon joining it and making an application for recognition.

O.Ph.D 2. Procedure for Admission

2.1:

(a) The University shall lay down and decide, in the beginning of the term/semester, a predetermined and manageable number of doctoral students, based on the number of teachers recognised to guide doctoral research in any given subject-discipline and the vacancies with them. No supervisor shall have more than the number of Ph. D. scholars beyond the following quota at any given point of time: (a) Professor-08; Associate Professor-06; and Assistant Professor-4 or as per UGC guidelines from time to time. However, he/she shall be allowed to take eligible international student applicants against supernumerary seats, or in addition to the above numbers.

(b) A seat shall be considered to be vacant only after a registered research scholar submits his/her Synopsis for Ph. D.

(c) The University shall ensure that adequate research facilities are available/ made available before allocating the Ph. D. students to Ph. D. guides in various subject-disciplines.

(d) The available number of seats should be obtained from respective departments through DRC before notification. The University shall notify number of available seats for Ph. D., last date of submitting application form, date of entrance test and

1.5 A person recognized as an M.Phil. guide by this University or other universities shall be automatically recognized as an M.Phil. guide in this University upon joining it and making an application for recognition.

O.M.Phil. 2. Procedure for Admission

2.1:

a. The M. Phil. Programme shall be for a minimum duration of two (2) consecutive semesters/ one year and a maximum of four (4) consecutive semesters/ two years in each faculty will be of one year or two semesters.
The overall minimum credit requirement, including credit for the coursework, for the award of M.Phil. degree shall be not less than 24 credits.

b. Applicants for admission to M. Phil. shall be required to have a minimum 55% score under any evaluation system at the Master's level in the subject concerned.

c. Applicants who have qualified UGC/CSIR (JRF) Examinations/NET/ SLET/GATE/JEST, or have secured such any other national level fellowship for research shall be exempted from the M. Phil. Entrance test and will be given priority in the admission.

d. Admission to M. Phil. shall be through the M. Phil. Entrance Test to be conducted in the University by the P. G. Department concerned in each discipline. Candidate shall have to secure minimum 50% marks in entrance test.

e. Once the results of the M. Phil. Entrance Test are declared, the concerned P. G. Department shall notify a merit list and organize a formal counselling-cum-interview session.

f. The PG Department concerned shall call candidates for counselling- cum-interview session according to merit, wherein these candidates shall be expected to discuss their research interest/area in the context of their Research Proposals with the members of the Research Committee.

g. Each P. G. Department shall admit only a pre-determined number of students to its M.Phil. programme.

h. International students shall be exempted from the M. Phil. Entrance Test.

i. The University shall decide on the honorarium for paper setting and conduct of M. Phil. Entrance Test from time to time.

2.2:

The University shall lay down and decide, on an annual basis, a predetermined and manageable number of M. Phil. students, based on the number of teachers recognised to guide for M. Phil. in any given subject-discipline. No supervisor shall have more than the number of MPhil students beyond the following quota at any given point of time: (a) Professor-03; Associate Professor-02; and Assistant



Ordinances

O. P. G. D. 1: Eligibility

I For Admission: Any graduate in a relevant subject in the any discipline of any University, accepted as equivalent thereto by the Executive Council/relevant authority, subject to such conditions as may be prescribed. The university will follow the criteria for admissions with reference to the minimum marks or its equivalent grade for various categories of students, as prescribed by the Government of Gujarat/UGC/MHRD.

II For the P.G. Diploma: The candidates shall have subsequently undergone the prescribed course of study in the university department or a college affiliated to this University for a period of not less than one academic year, passed the examinations prescribed and fulfilled such conditions as have been prescribed.

O. P. G. D. 2: Course of Study:

The syllabus for the course of study will be prescribed from time to time by BOS/relevant body.

O. P. G. D. 3: Intake:

As the nature of the work of this university is unique and teaching is one of the parts of the work assigned in the act of the university, maximum intake shall be 30 after that there shall be 5 seats on self-finance bases or as decided by respective regulatory body.

O. P. G. D. 4: Credit:

The term 'Credit' refers to the weightage given to a course, usually in relation to the instructional hours assigned to it. PGD programme will be divided into two semesters. Each semester will consist of Minimum twenty credits. In every semester minimum 03 Core Course (CC), 01 Elective Course (EC) and 01 Foundation Course/Soft Skill or Generic would be there. One theory credit = 01 hour and one practical credit = 02 hours per week could be allocated. Distribution of the total credits should be allocated as given below Table no.1

O. P. G. D. 5: Duration :

The P.G.Diplomaprogramme comprise of two semesters. At the end of the semester there will be an examination. The student will be allowed to complete all the theory courses and the dissertation work/practical work within a period of additional/extended one year.

O.P.G.D. 8. The CBCS System:

Programmes shall run on Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) pattern.

O.P.G.D. 9 Courses in Programmes:

The PG Diploma Programme consists of a number of courses. The term 'course' is applied to indicate a logical part of the subject matter of the programme and is invariably equivalent to the subject matter of a "paper" in the conventional sense. The following are the various categories of Courses suggested for the PG Diploma - programmes. Core, Elective Courses and Foundation/Generic/Soft skill Courses and such other courses deemed necessary for the programme.

The number of courses per semester would be minimum five comprising of minimum twenty credits, including practical courses and work experience. However, the number of courses may be reduced to accommodate the dissertation/project work etc. as per the requirement.

O. P. G. D. 10 Extension and Co-Curricular Activities:


