EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATIONS: Minimum Educational Qualifications, Experience and Publication etc. for all the posts shall be applicable as prescribed by the "UGC REGULATIONS ON MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS FOR APPOINTMENT OF TEACHERS AND OTHER ACADEMIC STAFF IN UNIVERSITIES AND COLLEGES AND MEASURES FOR THE MAINTENANCE OF STANDARDS IN HIGHER EDUCATION, 2018 and concerned statutory bodies.

Qualifications for the Post of: Professor

1. Professor of Language/Linguistics

- A.
- (1) Master degree in any of the languages of the VIIIth schedule or Linguistics.
- (2) Doctoral degree in any of the languages of VIIIth schedule or Linguistics on a topic of Language teaching/Language text book production.
- (3) High quality publication or production (in any form of media) on language development in children or teaching language.
- (4) An eminent scholar having Ph.D. degree in the concerned/allied/relevant discipline, and published work of high quality, actively engaged in research with evidence of published work with, a minimum of 10 research publications in the peer-reviewed or UGC listed journals and a total research score of 120 as per the criteria given in Appendix II, Table 2.
- (5) A minimum of ten years of teaching experience in a university/college as Assistant Professor/Associate Professor/Professor, and / or research experience at equivalent level at the University/National Level Institution with evidence of having successfully guided doctoral candidate.

OR

B. An outstanding professional, having Ph.D. degree in the relevant/allied/applied discipline, from any academic institution (not included in A above) who has made significant contribution to the knowledge in the concerned/allied/relevant discipline, supported by documentary evidence provided he/she has ten years' experience.



2. Professor of Engineering & Technology/Design Eligibility:

A. Ph. D. degree in relevant field and First class or equivalent at either Bachelor's or Master's level in the relevant branch.

and

B. Minimum of 10 years of experience in teaching / research / industry out of which at least 3 years shall be at a post equivalent to that of an Associate Professor.

and

C. At least 6 research publications at the level of Associate Professor in SCI journals / UGC / AICTE approved list of journals and at least 2 successful Ph.D. guided as Supervisor / Cosupervisor till the date of Advertisement.

or

- **C.** At least 10 research publications at the level of Associate Professor in SCI journals / UGC / AICTE approved list of journals till the date of Advertisement.
- **D. Preferable**: having experience in the field of Toy Design/Making.

Qualifications for the Post of: Associate Professor

I. Associate Professor: Geography, Mathematics and Home Science.

- I. A good academic record, with a Ph.D. Degree in the concerned/allied/relevant disciplines.
- II. A Master's Degree with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point-scale, wherever the grading system is followed).
- III. A minimum of eight years of experience of teaching and / or research in an academic/research position equivalent to that of Assistant Professor in a University, College or Accredited Research Institution/industry with a minimum of seven publications in the peer-reviewed or UGC listed journals and a total research score of Seventy-five (75) as per the criteria given in Appendix II, Table 2.



II. Associate Professor: Creative Arts (Visual) Eligibility (A or B):

A.

- I. Good academic record, with a doctoral degree.
- II. Performing ability of a high professional standard.
- III. Eight year's experience of teaching in a University or College and / or of research in a University/national level institution, equal to that of Assistant Professor in a University/College.
- IV. Has made a significant contribution to knowledge in the subject concerned, as evidenced by quality publications.

OR

- B. A traditional or a professional artist with highly-commendable professional achievement having Master's degree in the subject concerned, who has:
 - I. been 'A'-grade artist of AIR/Doordarshan;
 - II. eight years' experience of outstanding performing achievement in the field of specialisation;
- III. experience in designing of new courses and /or curricula;
- IV. participated in National level Seminars/Conferences/Concerts in reputed institutions' and
- V. ability to explain, with logical reasoning, the subject concerned and adequate knowledge to teach theory with illustrations in the said discipline.

III. Associate Professor: Education

I. A Master's Degree in Arts/ Humanities/ Sciences/ Commerce and M.Ed. each with a minimum of 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed)

OR

M.A. (Education) and B.Ed. with 55% marks in each (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed)

- II. Ph. D in Education.
- III. A minimum of eight years of experience of teaching and / or research in an academic/research position equivalent to that of Assistant Professor in a University, College or Accredited Research Institution with a minimum of seven publications in the peer-reviewed or UGC listed journals and a total research score of Seventy-five (75) as per the criteria given in Appendix II, Table 2.

IV. Associate Professor: Engineering & Technology/Design.

I. Ph.D. degree in the relevant field and First class or equivalent at either Bachelor's or Master's level in the relevant branch

And

II. At least total 6 research publications in SCI journals / UGC / AICTE approved list of journals.

And

- III. Minimum of 8 years of experience in teaching / research / industry out of which at least 2 years shall be Post Ph.D. experience.
- **Note:** In case of HMCT, 8 years of industry experience at a managerial level not below the position of Head of Department handling a team of 20 persons or more in a 4 star hotel or above category or in a similar position in the hospitality industry / tourism industry.

Qualifications for the Post of: Assistant Professor

1. Assistant Professor: Social Work

- (i) A Master's degree with 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point-scale wherever the grading system is followed) in a concerned/relevant/allied subject from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign university.
- (ii) Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC or the CSIR, or a similar test accredited by the UGC, like SLET/SET or who are or have been awarded a Ph. D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of M.Phil./Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009 or 2016 and their amendments from time to time as the case may be exempted from NET/SLET/SET:

Provided, the candidates registered for the Ph.D. programme prior to July 11, 2009, shall be governed by the provisions of the then existing Ordinances/Bye-laws/Regulations of the Institution awarding the degree and such Ph.D. candidates shall be exempted from the requirement of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and

appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities/Colleges/Institutions subject to the fulfilment of the following conditions:

- a) The Ph.D. degree of the candidate has been awarded in a regular mode;

OR

M.A. (Education) and B.Ed. with 55% marks in each (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed)

(ii) Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC or the CSIR, or a similar test accredited by the UGC, like SLET/SET or who are or have been awarded a Ph. D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of M.Phil./Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009 or 2016 and their amendments from time to time as the case may be exempted from NET/SLET/SET :
