About the University :

Children's University, Gandhinagar was established in the year 2009. The concept of establishing the University of this Kind was conceptualized by Hon. Prime Minister Shri Narendrabhai Modi, then the chief minister of Gujarat. He formulated the motto 'Every Child Matters'.

It is said that the children are the future of any nation. The conception, nurturing and upbringing of the children should be done in a manner that they are the assets for the nation. The university caters to the society by educating the parents to bring desired child for them. The university functions in accordance to four pillars mentioned in the Act of the university i.e. education, training, research and extension. About the Department :

It is a multidisciplinary course which is driven by the theories from disciplines like sociology, psychology, economics, philosophy, anthropology and environmental science. The course utilizes scientific methods that can be applied while dealing with problems at the individual, group and community level.

Social work is a practice based profession and an academic discipline which emphasizes upon the inculcation of ethics and values amongst the students while working with people in practical settings. It is because of this purpose, continuous training throughout the course becomes its essential feature. Social work students get engaged in extensive and rigorous field work training within the community with direct interventions or through various national and international developmental organizations and government institutions. It eventually equips the students to address various social issues and concerns.

Social work programme at Children's University, Gandhinagar was introduced at Post Graduation level in the year 2018 with current intake capacity of 35 students from diverse disciplines.

Currently, the department has total faculty strength of three Assistant Professors from diverse academic backgrounds and specializations.
