The Academic Programmes on offer include: PhD in Psychology and Social Work, Master's Degree Programme in Psychology and Social Work.

The courses offered by the School of Humanities endeavour at imparting and generating knowledge and information on emerging issues and problems of contemporary society, economy, environment, human behaviour and polity. The course structure is choice based, flexible and is interdisciplinary in nature to cater to the mammoth segment of the society, the youth. At the end of the course, a student would be equipped with analytical skills, social science theoretical knowledge based on empirical and field-based learning. Thus, a student with this kind of learning can look forward to careers in teaching, counselling, management, NGO, public health, Sustainable Development, research, policy making, development sector, media and administration and so on.

The programmes offered by disciplines relate to core subject areas but at the same time straddle disciplines, in order to enlarge the canvas for academic pursuits. The School also links the development of courses to the ever-expanding socio-economic and political contexts in which School of Humanities and Social Science processes occur. The school of Humanities functions aligned with the noble objectives of Children's University.

The main function of school of humanities is divided into four parts:

### Education:

## About Department of Psychology

The Department of Psychology of Children's University is interested in the holistic development of children up to the age of 18. Courses like M.A in Child Psychology and PhD in psychology have started in 2016 and 2017 respectively. The origin of the Department of Psychology was one of the significant contributions by Prof K. S. Likhiya -the former Vice-Chancellor of Children's University. Dr. Ashok Prajapati was the first Professor in charge of the Department and He worked successfully to initiate these three courses. At present, the Department is headed by Prof. B. D. Dhila who has joined the department as professor in 2020.

To develop the skill and techniques of research in students of PG level, Project work and writing dissertation are introduced in the syllabus itself. The laboratory of psychology department is equipped with all the necessary instruments and psychological tests. The department is equipped with highly qualified and trained staff members so the students get the proper guidance regularly.

After completion of master degree, students get the guidance for M.Phil. and Ph.D degree from the department. In addition to that students are encouraged to present their research papers in various conferences and seminars. Students also get the guidance for the preparation of UGC JRF/NET and GSET examination. In the post-graduation courses there is a lot of emphasis on Child psychology so the students can get employment in the relevant areas of child development.

## About Department of Social Work

Department of Social Work had its existence way back in 2018-19 in Children's University. The programme, where the thrust of the current research endeavors in the areas like Healthcare, Reproductive and Child Health Programme (RCH), HIV/AIDS, ICDS Services, Panchayati Raj, Non-Governmental Organizations, Women in Unorganized Sector, Self Help Groups, Corporate Voluntarism, Water and Sanitation, Disaster Management, Psychosocial problems of Elderly, Cancer, Tuberculosis, etc. The department has initiated outreach activities in nearby rural communities.



## M.Phil. – Social Work

M.Phil. (Social Work) is a year's full time course which is divided into 2 semesters. This course focuses on building an advanced social research and analytical skills. Aim of this course to provide an understanding of the discipline of social work through specific thematic theorizations, theoretical reports, and a complex understanding of the field to enable a framework. This course uses multi method and trans-disciplinary training to prepare students as future leaders in education and social work research.

In the contemporary era, the study of ancient literature gains lots of attention. Scholars across the global traditions have remained keen to study this language for ages. The Department of Sanskrit is determined to cover following three points in relation to this language: (i) Research in the different forms of sixty four arts, (ii) Study of Spirituality and Great Ideals of life and (iii) learning Sanskrit literature from Indian point of view.

### Four Dimensions of Department

The central aim of Department of Sanskrit is to foster studies on Indian Eugenics, to study the sixteen Samsakaras from scientific point of view, to make the married couples understand the significance of Garbhadhan Samskar and to guide parents for the holistic development of a child with the help of value-based education. The Department also wants to re-establish the old frame of family system and is determined to present a critique of so-called modern family system. 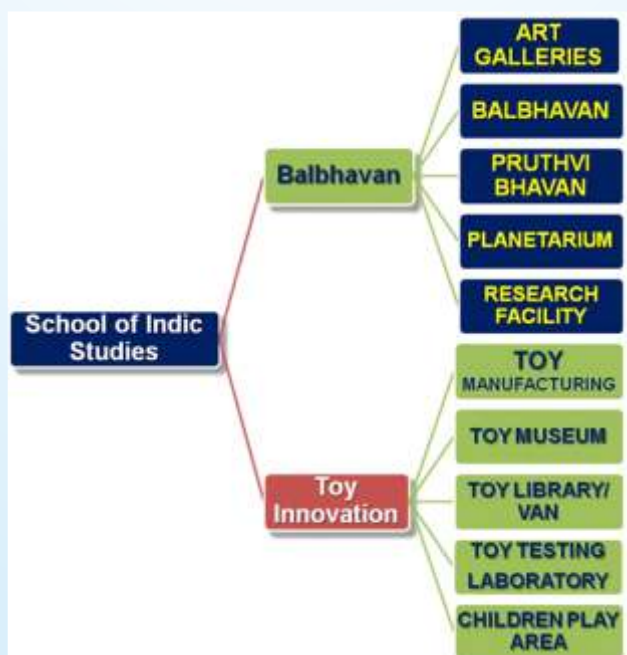

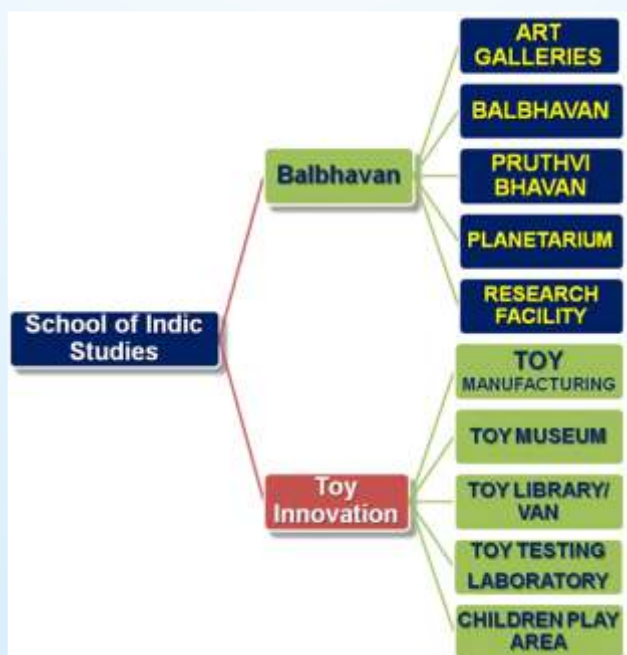
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### Departmental Structure

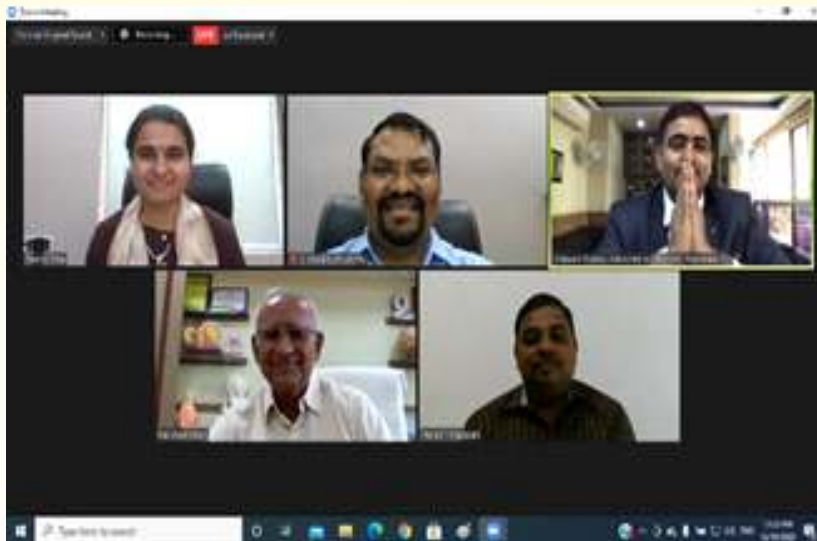
The training consisted of activity-oriented sessions on a variety of topics.

## કુલપતિશ્રીની કલમે...

આ બે માસ દરમિયાન બનેલી એક અતિ મહત્વની ઘટના એટલે ચિલ્ડ્રન્સ યુનિવર્સિટી, ગાંધીનગર ખાતે તા. ૨૦/૦૨/૨૦૨૧ના રોજ ગુજરાતના મા. રાજ્યપાલ તેમજ ચિલ્ડ્રન્સ યુનિવર્સિટીના મા. કુલાધિપતિ શ્રી આચાર્ય દેવવ્રતજીના અધ્યક્ષસ્થાને પ્રથમ દીક્ષાંત સમારોહનું આયોજન કરવામાં આવ્યું. આ સમારોહમાં મા. કુલાધિપતિશ્રી આચાર્ય દેવવ્રતજીએ દીક્ષાંત પ્રવચન દ્વારા ચિલ્ડ્રન્સ યુનિવર્સિટીનાં ધ્યેય, દર્શન અને તેની રચનાના ઉદ્દેશને સૌની સમક્ષ સાવ સરળ અને અસરકારક શબ્દોમાં મૂકી આપ્યાં. તેનો ટૂંકસાર અહીં રજૂ કરવો યથોચિત ગણાશે.

સભાને સંબોધતાં પોતાના દીક્ષાંત પ્રવચનની શરૂઆત તેમણે આ રીતે કરી હતી.

**“ ઓમ્ વિદ્યાં ચાવિદ્યાં ચ યસ્તદ્વેદોભયં સહ ।**

**અવિદ્યાયા મૃત્યું તીર્ત્વા વિદ્યાયામૃતમશ્નુતે ”**

વિદ્યાના મહાત્મ્યને સમજાવતા આ શ્લોકથી શરૂઆત કર્યા બાદ તેમણે જણાવ્યું હતું કે, “આજે આપણા બધાં માટે અપાર પ્રસન્નતાનો દિવસ છે કે ભારતના યશસ્વી પ્રધાનમંત્રી શ્રીમાન નરેન્દ્ર મોદીજીએ પ્રાચીન ભારતીય પરંપરાઓને અને માનવકલ્યાણના સૂત્રને ધ્યાનમાં રાખીને વિશ્વની પહેલી યુનિવર્સિટી ‘ચિલ્ડ્રન્સ યુનિવર્સિટી’ની સ્થાપના કરાવી. આજે આ યુનિવર્સિટીનો પ્રથમ દીક્ષાંત સમારોહ છે અને એમાં આજે જે વિદ્યાર્થીઓએ સુવર્ણપદક અને પદવી મેળવી છે એ સૌને હું ખૂબ ખૂબ અભિનંદન અને સાધુવાદ આપું છું. આ એવા વિદ્યાર્થીઓ છે જેમણે ચિલ્ડ્રન્સ યુનિવર્સિટીની પ્રથમ ડિગ્રી મેળવી છે, તે એમના માટે ખૂબ ગૌરવની વાત છે. આજે ચિલ્ડ્રન્સ યુનિવર્સિટી દ્વારા માનનીય પ્રધાનમંત્રીશ્રીનો શુભ સંકલ્પ મૂર્તિમંત થયો છે.” તેમણે વધુમાં જણાવ્યું કે, “આજના ભૌતિક ઉન્નતિના યુગમાં મા. વડાપ્રધાનશ્રીએ ઉત્તમ મનુષ્યના નિર્માણ માટે ચિલ્ડ્રન્સ યુનિવર્સિટીની સ્થાપના કરી તે આપણા સૌ માટે આનંદ અને ગૌરવની વાત છે. આજે ઈશ્વરીય વ્યવસ્થાને ખોરવી નાખવાનું કાર્ય મનુષ્યએ કર્યું છે. અસલી નિર્માણ તો મનુષ્યનું નિર્માણ છે. આજના આ ભૌતિકવાદી યુગમાં આપણે સૌએ આપણી બધી જ શક્તિઓને એવાં કામ પાછળ લગાવી છે કે આપણે કેટલી રેલવે બનાવી, કેટલી નહેરોની જાળ બિછાવી, કેટલા વધારે રસ્તાઓ બનાવ્યા, કેટલાં વધારે કારખાનાં બનાવ્યાં તેનો જ વિચાર કરીએ છીએ. વર્તમાન સાયન્સ અને ટેકનોલોજીના આધારે કેટલો વધારે વિકાસ કરવામાં આવે કે જેથી એને સૌથી મોટી ઉન્નતિ માનવામાં આવે ! આ આપણી એવી પ્રગતિ છે કે જેને ભૌતિક ઉન્નતિ કહેવામાં આવે છે. પરંતુ ધ્યાન રહે કે આ બધી ભૌતિક ઉન્નતિનો ઉપભોગ જેમણે કરવાનો છે એ મનુષ્ય જો માણસ નહીં બને તો એ ઉન્નતિ જ એના માટે દુઃખનું કારણ બનશે. અસલી નિર્માણ તો મનુષ્યનિર્માણ છે, કે જે આ સમગ્ર વિકાસ અને સૃષ્ટિનો ઉપભોક્તા છે.

આખી ઈશ્વરીય વ્યવસ્થાને આજે જે નુકસાન પહોંચ્યું છે, આજે જે આ બધી વ્યવસ્થાઓનો આંધળો ઉપભોગ થયો છે, તેને તોડી મરોડીને, ગ્લોબલ-વોર્મિંગ સ્વરૂપ આપવામાં આવ્યું છે એ સ્વરૂપ કોઈ પ્રાણી કે પંખીઓએ નથી આપ્યું, તેનો વિનાશ કર્યો છે તો તે આ સમજદાર

માણસે કર્યો છે. આ બધી વ્યવસ્થાઓને વ્યવસ્થિત રીતે ચલાવવાનું કાર્ય અને એ માટેનું બુદ્ધિકૌશલ્ય ભગવાને કોઈને આપ્યું છે તો તે માત્ર મનુષ્યને આપ્યું છે. એટલે એના નિર્માણ અને વિનાશ બંને મનુષ્યના હાથમાં છે. જો મનુષ્ય સાચા અર્થમાં મનુષ્ય બન્યો, નૈતિક અને સંસ્કારી બન્યો, સંવેદનશીલ બન્યો, પ્રત્યેકનાં સુખ-દુઃખને પોતાનાં સુખ-દુઃખ માનવાવાળો બની ગયો તો આખી દુનિયા સ્વર્ગ બની જશે અને એના સામે પક્ષે જો એ સ્વાર્થી બન્યો, ખોટું બોલનાર બન્યો, ચોરી કરનાર બન્યો અને કાળાબજાર કરનારો બન્યો, અન્યને દુઃખ આપનાર બન્યો તો દુનિયા નર્ક બની શકે છે !”

તેમણે સોળ સંસ્કાર, ગર્ભસ્થ શિશુનું શિક્ષણ, બાળકની ગ્રહણશક્તિ અને શ્રેષ્ઠ મનુષ્ય થકી શ્રેષ્ઠ રાષ્ટ્રના નિર્માણની વાત કરી અને તે થકી વિશ્વકલ્યાણની ભાવના વ્યક્ત કરી હતી. વિશ્વના શ્રેષ્ઠ મનોવૈજ્ઞાનિક સિગ્મંડ ફ્રોઈડની વાત અને ઉદાહરણ દ્વારા તેમણે જણાવ્યું હતું કે ભારત જેવા સમૃદ્ધ સંશોધન પરંપરા ધરાવતા દેશ પાસે મનુષ્ય-નિર્માણની પ્રક્રિયા માતાના ગર્ભકાળથી જ શરૂ કરવાની વાત પર ભાર આપવામાં આવ્યો હતો. એ જ વાત અને વિચારને આજે ચિલ્ડ્રન્સ યુનિવર્સિટી પોતાનાં કાર્યો મારફતે ચરિતાર્થ કરી રહી છે તેનો આપણે સૌએ ગર્વ લેવો જોઈએ.

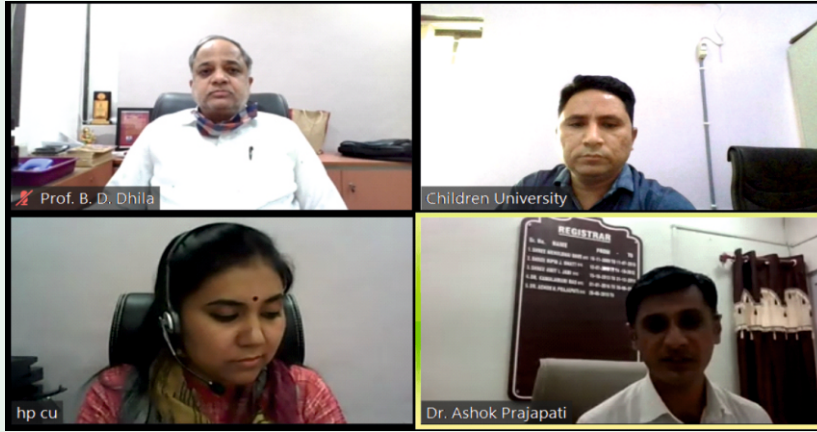




## ૭. 'સ્ટ્રેસ મેનેજમેન્ટ' વિષય પર વેબિનાર
